Dear parents and carers,

As we near the end of Autumn Term 1, I wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of uniform expectations. Over the last few weeks, we have noticed a decline in the number of pupils wearing the correct school uniform, including PE kits. Wearing the correct school uniform creates an identify for the academy and is an important part of being a pupil at Norbridge. Uniforms also create a sense of belonging and an identify for the academy in the local community.

## **Uniform Expectations**

Trainers must not be worn other than for PE.

## Jewellery

Children will not be permitted to wear items of jewellery apart from small, studded ear-rings. These must be removed on PE days. Watches are allowed but smart watches will not be permitted.

## PE / Gymnastics

Children will have a weekly P.E session with Mr Scott. Throughout the academic year, some children will have a Gymnastics lesson with Mrs Spencer.

Please ensure on your child's PE / Gymnastics Day, they attend school wearing their appropriate kit. This includes:

- A plain white t-shirt (with or without a school logo)
- A pair of black shorts
- Plain blue or black joggers and a hoodie for cold weather (no logos)
- Trainers (Indoor PE is done in bare feet or plimsolls)

## A polite reminder that football kits and/or sportswear with branded logos are not permitted.

From Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November, we will be closely monitoring the wearing of the correct school uniform, **including PE kits.** We will be making telephone calls home to parents/carers in cases where pupils are not wearing the correct uniform and will request that this is brought to school. In cases where the uniform is still not adhered to, the academy will provide spare uniform/kit for the duration of the school day.
