On behalf of the staff, I wish you all a very merry Christmas and best wishes for the New Year. See you on Tuesday 7th January.

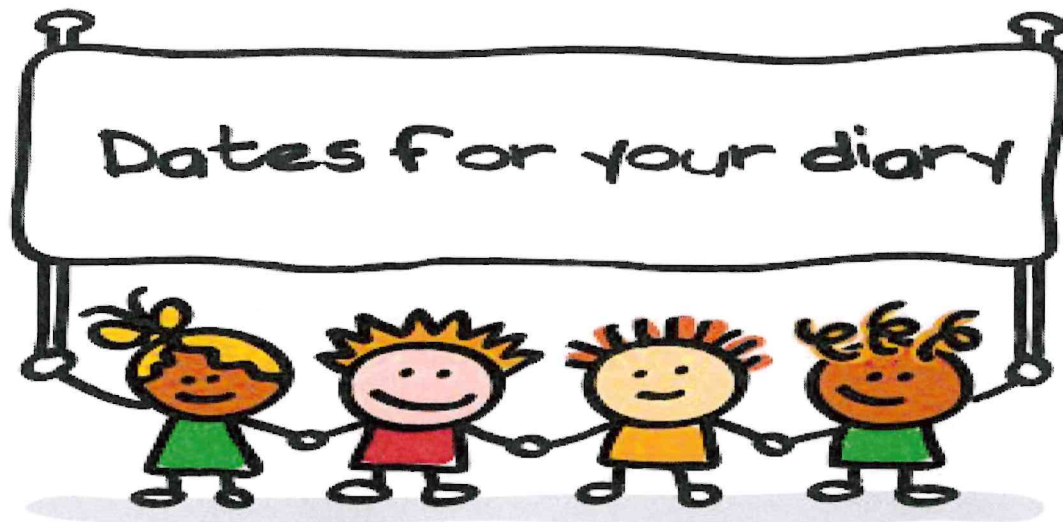
